Minutes from June meeting were read and motion to approve minutes was moved by Don Hirsch and seconded by Carolyn Pottinger, roll was called and passed unanimously.

General Funds and Road District bills were reviewed and motion to approve disbursements was made by Don Hirsch and seconded by Zach Turnbow, roll was called and passed unanimously.
