At the regular monthly Town Meeting held in said town and county, in the state of Illinois at Kendall Township Hall on Tuesday December 21st, 2021. Meeting was called to order at 7:33 PM by Supervisor Steve Gengler. Township officials present were Steve Gengler - Supervisor, Doug Westphal - Highway Commissioner, Steve Grebner - Town Clerk and all trustees: Carolyn Pottinger, Doug Thanepohn and Zach Turnbow. Absent were Don Hirsch, Trustee and Cathy Scalise - Kendall Township Assessor.

Supervisor Gengler lead the board in the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

Representative from the Sheriff's Dept was present and indicated that due to the incident that occurred Monday evening, the County has been quite busy covering Yorkville Police's calls for service. Fleet upgrades are in process and proceeding slowly – new vehicles as well as new radios. Testing is underway and working through the issues to identify the best equipment to outfit the County Sheriff's Dept.

There was no other public comment was forthcoming.

Minutes from November meeting were read and motion to approve minutes was moved by Carolyn Pottinger and seconded by Zach Turnbow and motion passed with a unanimous vote by supervisor and trustees.

General Funds and Road District bills were reviewed and motion to approve disbursements was made by Zach Turnbow and seconded by Carolyn Pottinger. Motion was approved unanimously.

Supervisor: We have made the approved General Assistance payments from that fund.

### **New Business:**

Highway Commissioner: First Salt of the season has arrived from the new vendor Compass Minerals and very pleased with the quality of the road salt. 275 tons on hand at Township building plus more at the large communal dome in Yorkville. Road commissioner did bring up the fact (given the discussion about the potential new radios for County Sheriff vehicles) that if that occurs, he would like to have a radio in township vehicle to have the ability to communicate with County vehicles during an event (snow storm for example). That will be taken under advisement once new radio platform has been determined.

Highway Commissioner did state it has been reported to him of an increase in garbage as well as large concrete chunks in ditches on Township roads of late.

Assessor: Assessor was not in attendance but had reported to Supervisor that we continue to see New Certificates of Occupancy in township.

Supervisor: We are still looking into the Backup Generator for the Township Building.

Discussion Items:

We are looking into a replacement for our printer due to quality issues (and age) of existing multifunction printer and working with the Assessor to ensure the replacement selected meets her department's needs as that group utilizes it at the highest rate. Looking into the most economical solution – Buy vs Lease.

Motion to approve said Ordinance was made by Carolyn Pottinger and seconded by Zach Turnbow. Motion passed unanimously with 4 votes to approve (Don Hirsch absent). Clerk Grebner will deliver to County Clerk for filing as per state statute tomorrow (Wednesday).

Tax Levy Ordinance for Kendall Township Ordinance Number 21-04 was reviewed and discussion ensued. Motion to approve said Ordinance was made by Doug Thanepohn and seconded by Carolyn Pottinger. Motion passed unanimously with 4 votes to approve (Don Hirsch absent). Clerk Grebner will deliver to County Clerk for filing as per state statute tomorrow (Wednesday).
