

Ordinance No. 24-04



**AN ORDINANCE ELECTING PARTICIPATION OF
A TOWNSHIP IN IMRF**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ELECTORS OF THE TOWN OF Kendall, THAT:

WHEREAS, at the annual town meeting, the electors authorized the town supervisor to file an applictaion on behalf of the town to participate in the Illinois Municipal Retirement Fund; and

WHEREAS, the application of the town has been filed with and approved by the Board of Trustees of the Illinois Municipal Retirement Fund; and

WHEREAS, the town, by adoption of the Electors of an Ordinance may elect to participate in the Illinois Municipal Retirement Fund to begin on the 1st day of January following the adoption of the Ordinance and filing of the Ordinance with the Board of Trustees of the Illinois Municipal Retirement Fund; and

WHEREAS, the election to participate in the Illinois Municipal Retirement Fund is irrevocable and participation will continue as long as the town exists;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the electors of the Town of

Kendall, Kendall County, Illinois,

that said town and all other bodies politic, heretofore or hereafter established by, or under direct or indirect control of the electors, shall participate as a single municipality in the Illinois Municipal Retirement Fund, so that participation will be effective on January 1, 20 25.
